- 1. The Feast of Mary, Help of Christians, will be celebrated on Thursday, 24th May 2012.
- 2. All students should return to school in full summer uniform before 8:10 a.m. and go to their own classroom before 8:30 a.m.. The Class teachers should take the roll-call and the class monitors should hand in the Registers to the school office before 8:45a.m.
- 3. At 8:45 a.m., all Catholic students should gather and line up at the basketball court and proceed to the school chapel for a Holy Mass.
- 4. The Holy Mass will be celebrated for the Catholics and Catechumens (i.e. those who attend the catechism formation during the General Education lessons) in the school chapel.
